The Council informs the Board of Directors about issues and needs in the low-income community. Make recommendations on the impact of programs and services offered by Panhandle Community Services. Promote Panhandle Community Services in the services area.

Area	Responsibility
1. Administration	 The Council meets quarterly to discuss the gaps in services needed to meet the needs of the low-income in the PCS service area. A low-income PCS Board of Directors representative will chair the Council. The Community Relations Director will serve as the staff lead. The Council will comprise two individuals elected from each Advisory Committee and a Communication Specialist elected by the Advisory Committees. The Council will organize and operate under Roberts Rules of Order.
2. Duties	 The Council will review current PCS programs and their effectiveness in the low-income community and make recommendations to the Board of Directors. The Council will assist in compiling information for the agency-wide scorecard. The Council will attend the annual Bridge Builders Luncheon and speak to the unmet needs in their communities. The Council will assist in the Community Needs Assessment every three years. Council members will be granted 2, 4, and 6-year terms. Review new grant applications for compliance with PCS's Mission, Vision, and Values.
3. Strategic Focus	 Advocate for and educate the communities about meaningful change for low-income people. Ensure the programs operated at PCS meet the agency's Mission, Vision, and Values. Ensure the Agency is on track with Organizational and Pathways Standards. Ensure the goals of programs are aligned with the Strategic Plan.
